


Our range of services

Services for local authorities and service providers

Strategic and complete management

C+K offers a range of services from a 'strategic NEET audit through to a complete NEET management service' all of which have been proven to decrease the number of young people and adults not in employment, education or training. Our work in Calderdale and Kirklees - where we offer a comprehensive and integrated NEET service - has helped rank the local authority 1st in Yorkshire and the Humber and in the top 20% nationally. This has been achieved by working closely with local authority staff, developing a unique partnership approach.

Identifying at-risk of NEET and targetted support

By identifying at-risk individuals early and providing tailored support and guidance, our qualified and professionally trained careers advisers are able to understand the issues, barriers and identify potential trends. Targeting support with this group of young people and adults, leads to better decision making and increased chances of successful progression. This support includes providing personalised careers information, advice, help with writing CVs, apprenticeship and course applications and preparing for interviews. Quite often, it is additional issues that make a young person or adult at risk of becoming NEET. C+K works closely with specialist support agencies to provide support for a range of issues including substance misuse, mental health, sexual health, family relationships and housing. By building trusted relationships with young people throughout their time in education and in adulthood, our dedicated, experienced frontline advisers are able to focus resources and provide personalised support to those that need it most.

Services for businesses and employers



We have a dedicated Professional Services Team that are committed to building relationships with employers to enable them to work with local cohorts of young people and adults.

Recruiting staff and vacancy matching

With a team of over 60 frontline advisers, delivering over 10,000 careers interventions to over 3,000 young people and adults every year, C+K is ideally placed to match your vacancies with suitable candidates free of charge. Recruitment of new employees can be a time-consuming and expensive task. By working with C+K, we can develop tailored engagement programmes that raise awareness of vacancies and encourage applications.

Virtual work experience and raising awareness of your organisation

Our work experience offer allows employers to showcase their organisation to young people and link in with the workforce of the future. We are currently working with organisations to deliver virtual work experience, which allows young people to experience the world of work but ensure that they stay COVID-safe.

Advisers working in schools and colleges provide opportunities for employers to raise awareness of their organisation via mock interviews, careers events, or taking part in dragons' den-style enterprise events. Some companies use these opportunities to demonstrate their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and C+K can help

develop activities for this purpose. We also deliver The Nexus In-School project, a partnership between Kirklees Council and C+K to offer a range of extended work placements with local employers and a dedicated project officer to mentor and support students. Students will follow a comprehensive programme of personal and employability skills workshops during this one year programme.

Employability and careers guidance services for adults



C+K delivers a range of employability and careers guidance services for adults.

Working with us - a partnership approach

Every year we ensure that thousands of young people and adults receive high quality careers advice and guidance, to enable them to make the best possible decisions about their future. With Calderdale and Kirklees having some of the lowest NEET rates in the country - it is clear that this approach is demonstrated to work.

With new organisations setting up all the time, we are keen to ensure that we are partnering with everyone who is working in the wider youth and employability sector.
